


4-H Holiday Baking

December 21 | 9:00 AM-3:00 PM

Youth ages 9-19 will learn basic baking skills through hands-on activities such as how to safely use an oven, how to properly measure wet and dry ingredients, food safety, tool ID and how to read a recipe. Participants will need to bring a sack lunch and can sign up by bringing their \$10 registration fee to the Muhlenberg County Extension Office.

How to Sign Up for Clubs and Upcoming Projects

For all classes with a registration fee:

You must come by the Extension Office and register along with the payment during office hours: Monday-Friday, 8-4:30 PM. You must be registered one week in advance of any class so our instructors have time to prepare. For classes or project clubs with no fee, you may register by phone at 270-338-0710 during our office hours.

Remember, if you sign up for a class and don't show up you are keeping someone else from participating!



Are you planning for 4-H Camp?

It's not too early to be thinking ahead to 4-H Summer Camp! Camp will be held on June 17-21, 2024 in Dawson Springs, Kentucky. If you would like to start making payments on your child's summer camp you can come by the Extension Office to set up a payment plan. This also makes a great Christmas or birthday gift! Camp will be \$315 for 9-14 year olds and \$165 for 15-17 year olds.

Gingerbread House Decorating Class
